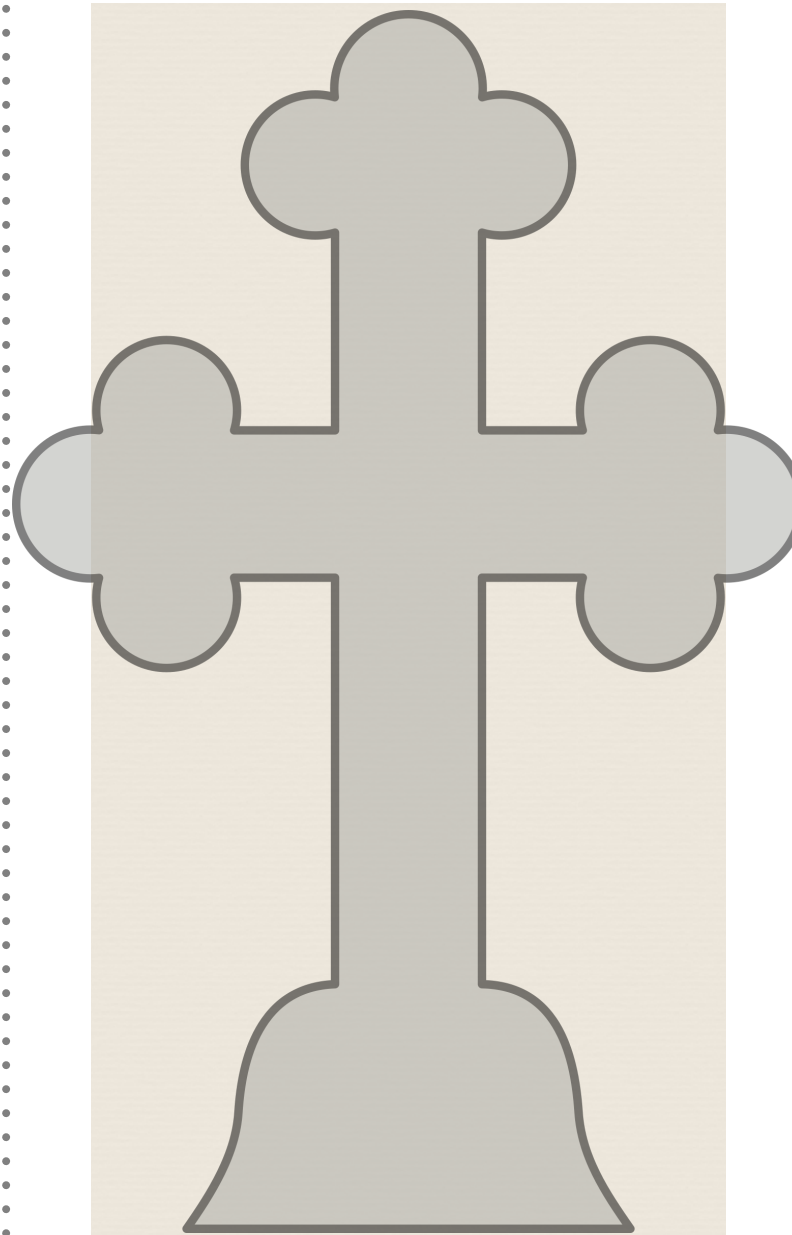

Fr. Maximos Conostas is Senior Research Scholar at Holy Cross Greek Orthodox School of Theology, in Brookline, Mass. He holds a Ph.D. in Patristics and Historical Theology from the Catholic University of America, in Washington, D.C. For many years he was a professor of theology at Harvard Divinity School, after which he became a monk at the Monastery of Simonopetra (Mt. Athos, Greece). He is the author of *The Art of Seeing: Paradox and Perception in Orthodox Iconography* (Alhambra, 2014); an edition and translation of *St Maximos the Confessor, On Difficulties in the Church Fathers and many other books*.
