He maintains a private practice in New York City where he conducts forensic evaluations as well as threat assessments and management. In addition, he provides clinical assessments and treatment of juveniles and adults. Dr. Katsavdakís is retained by defense attorneys, prosecutors and the Court to evaluate defendants charged with violent crimes. He holds an Associate Professor-Adjunct position with CUNY/New York Law School. Dr. Katsavdakís serves as a Consultant with the United States Federal Government for threat assessment related to Counter Terrorism.
