EPISTLE READING

St. Paul's letter to the Heb. 4:14 - 16; 5:1 - 6

Brethren, since we have a high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. For we have not a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin. Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need. For every high priest chosen from among men is appointed to act on behalf of men in relation to God, to offer gifts and sacrifices for sins. He can deal gently with the ignorant and wayward, since he himself is beset with weakness. Because of this he is bound to offer sacrifice for his own sins as well as for those of the people. And one does not take the honor upon himself, but he is called by God, just as Aaron was. So also Christ did not exalt himself to be made a high priest, but was appointed by him who said to him, "You are my Son, today I have begotten you"; as he says also in another place, "You are a priest forever, according to the order of Melchizedek."

Ό Τίμιος Σταυρός είναι τό ἀξιώτερο σημεῖο καί σύμβολο τῆς πίστεώς μας. Σύμφωνα μέ τήν διδασκαλία τῆς Ἐκκλησίας μας ὁ σταυρός τοῦ Χριστοῦ είναι ἡ δόξα τοῦ Χριστοῦ, ἡ δόξα τῆς Ἐκκλησίας, τό θέλημα τοῦ Πατρός, ἡ δόξα τοῦ Μονογενοῦς, τό ἀγαλλίαμα τοῦ Πνεύματος, ὁ κόσμος τῶν Ἁγγέλων, ἡ ἀσφάλεια τῆς Ἐκκλησίας, τό τεῖχος τῶν Ἁγίων, τό φῶς τῆς Οἰκουμένης. Κατά τόν ἄγιο Γρηγόριο τόν Παλαμά «ὅχι μόνο ὁ λόγος περί Σταυροῦ καί τό μυστήριο, ἀλλά καί τό σχῆμα εἶναι θεῖο καί προσκυνητό, διότι εἶναι σφραγίδα σεβάσμια, ἀγιαστική καί τελειωτική ὅλων τῶν θαυμασίων καί ἀνεκφράστων ἀγαθῶν, τά ὁποῖα προέρχονται ἀπό τόν Θεό». Ὅλη ἡ κένωση, ἡ πτωχεία, ἡ ἐξουθένωση, ἡ ὀδύνη, ὁ θάνατος, ποῦ ἔλαβε γιά μᾶς ὁ Χριστός κορυφώνονται στόν σταυρό. Ὅλα τά ἰερά μυστήρια τελειώνονται μέ τήν ἐπίκληση τοῦ Ἁγίου Πνεύματος καί τήν σφραγίδα τοῦ σταυροῦ. Οἱ ἰ. Ναοί, τά ἰερά σκεύη καί τά ἄμφια ἀγιάζονται μέ τόν Τίμιο Σταυρό. Δέν νοεῖται λειτουργική πράξη ἡ σύναξη τῶν πιστῶν χωρίς τήν σφραγίδα τοῦ Τιμίου Σταυροῦ.

Ό σταυρός τοῦ Χριστοῦ Ἡ χάρη καί ἡ δύναμη τοῦ Τιμίου Σταυροῦ ὀφείλεται ὅχι στό σχήμα του, ὅτι δηλαδή εἶναι σταυρός, ἀλλά στό ὅτι εἶναι ὁ σταυρός τοῦ Χριστοῦ, τό μέσο διά τοῦ ὁποίου ὁ Χριστός ἔσωσε τόν κόσμο. Εἶναι τό θυσιαστήριο στό ὁποῖο προσέφερε τόν ἑαυτό του θυσία γιά ὅλο τόν κόσμο, ὡς θύτης καί ὡς θῦμα. Στόν σταυρό ἔζησε τόν βαθύτερο πόνο, καί τόν μεγαλύτερο ἑξευτελισμό γιά ἑμᾶς. Ἔγινε «ὑπέρ ἡμῶν» κατάρα γιά να μᾶς ἐλευθερώσει ἀπό τήν κατάρα τῆς ἀμαρτίας καί τοῦ νόμου. Ὅλο τό ἔργο τοῦ Χριστοῦ, ὅλη ἡ φιλανθρωπία του συνοψίζονται στήν σταυρική του θυσία. Καί ὅταν ὁ Πέτρος συμβούλευσε τόν Χριστό νά ἀποφύγει τόν σταυρικό θάνατο, ὁ Κύριος τόν ἐπετίμησε αὐστηρά: «Ὑπαγε ὁπίσω μου σατανᾶ, ὅτι οὐ φρονεῖς τά τοῦ Θεοῦ ἀλλά τά τῶν ἀνθρώπων».

Σταυρός καί ἄνθρωπος Στόν σταυρό σταμάτησε ὁ παλαιός αἰώνας τοῦ θανάτου καί μέ τήν Ανάσταση τοῦ Χριστοῦ, ποῦ συνδέεται μέ τόν σταυρό, ἄρχισε ὁ νέος αἰώνας, ἡ ἐποχή τῆς θέωσης καί τῆς σωτηρίας τοῦ ἀνθρώπου. Στόν σταυρό ὁ Θεάνθρωπος Χριστός ἔλυσε τήν τραγωδία τῆς ἀνθρώπινης ἐλευθερίας γενόμενος ὑπήκοος μέχρι θανάτου, θανάτου δέ σταυροῦ, καί ἐπαναπροσανατόλισε τήν ἐλευθερία μας στόν Δημιουργό της τόν ἄγιο Τριαδικό Θεό. Διά τοῦ σταυροῦ μᾶς συμφιλίωσε μέ τόν Θεό Πατέρα καί μᾶς χάρισε τήν ἄφεση τῶν ἀμαρτιῶν μας. Διά τοῦ σταυροῦ συνήγαγε καί ἔνωσε σέ ἔνα σῶμα, τά πρώην διασκορπισμένα παιδιά τοῦ Θεοῦ. Στόν σταυρό, μέ τήν δική Του γεμάτη ἀπό ταπείνωση ὕψωση, ὕψωσε καί τήν δική μας φύση ποῦ μέ τήν ψεύτικη καί μάταιη οἴηση εἶχε καταβιβασθῆ μέχρι τόν Ἄδη. Στόν σταυρό ἀπεκάλυψε τόν ἑαυτό Του ὡς τόν μόνο εὐεργέτη καί. σωτῆρα, λυτρωτῆ καί ζωοδότη τοῦ σύμπαντος κόσμου καί κατέλυσε ὁριστικά τό ἔργο τοῦ διαβόλου.

Συμμετοχή στόν σταυρό Ζοῦμε σ' ἔναν κόσμο, στόν ὁποῖο κυριαρχεῖ τό ἀντισταυρικό πνεῦμα. Έναν κόσμο πού ἔχει ὡς ἰδανικά του τήν εὐημερία, τήν καλοζωΐα, τήν ἄνεση, πού τοποθετεῖ τήν ἐλευθερία ὅχι στήν θυσία καί τήν ἀγάπη, ἀλλά στόν ἐγωϊσμό. Ὁ σταυρός τοῦ Κυρίου, ὁ ὁποῖος ὑψώνεται στόν βίο τῆς Ἐκκλησίας στό μέσον τῆς Μεγάλης Τεσσαρακοστῆς, ὑπενθυμίζει σέ ὅλο τόν κόσμο καί σέ μᾶς ὅτι, ὅταν διαλέξουμε τόν σταυρό ὡς τρόπο τῆς ζωῆς μας, ὡς πολίτευμα τοῦ ἐκκλησιαστικοῦ μας βίου, τότε θά ἔχουμε καί τήν ἀνάσταση. Τότε βιώνουμε τήν ἀληθινή ἐλευθερία, τήν ἀληθινή ἀνάπαυση μέσα στήν ἀγάπη τοῦ Θεοῦ καί τήν ἀγάπη τῶν ἀδελφῶν μας, τήν ἀληθινή εἰρήνη τῆς ψυχῆς.







AHEPA SCHOLARSHIPS 2025

The Gus Chereyas Estia-Pindus Chapter No. 326 of the Order of AHEPA announces its scholarship program. Three \$2,000 scholarships to high-school seniors who plan to attend college in the Fall of 2025 are available. The application is only available in digital form. Students must complete the applications by May 11, 2025. To access the application, the link is www.bit.ly/4kyFsMw. Applicants can request documents pertaining to AHEPA's History and Mission, and AHEPA's 100 Years of Contributions to assist their knowledge about AHEPA which will help them with the application requirements by emailing the program Chairman Dean Moskos at moskos.ahepa326@verizon.net.



ELIGIBILITY: Applicants must be High School Seniors of Hellenic descent who reside in Queens and attend a High School in any NYC borough, and who plan to attend a College or University in the Fall of 2025. (Exception: AHEPA members of Chapter 326, regardless of where they reside, whose qualifying children or grandchildren intend to attend a College or University in the Fall of 2025.) The winner of the scholarship awards will be awarded on **AHEPA Sunday**, **June 7**, **2025**.

- In addition, the AHEPA Empire District No. 6 offers several scholarships to high-school seniors who plan to attend college in the Fall of 2025. The first scholarship is for \$5,000, the second for \$3,000, the third and fourth are for \$1,500 and the fifth one is for \$1,000. In addition, \$1.000 has been allocated for an additional scholarship to a high school senior who will pursue a career in vocational training at an accredited school, i.e. health care, construction, manufacturing, carpentry, electronics, plumbing, etc. The AHEPA District 6 application and requirements are available online and may be easily downloaded at https://www.ahepad6.com/chapter-resources, Please note that the entire application must be e-mailed as a PDF document by May 1, 2025, to d6scholarships@ahepad6.com. 




